Several members who attended the conference for the first time have stated that the networking and lessons learned at the annual conference has changed the way they manage, the way they look at the profession, and the arc of their career. MCMA hopes to continue that success this year in San Antonio by supporting our new members who have never attended an ICMA conference.

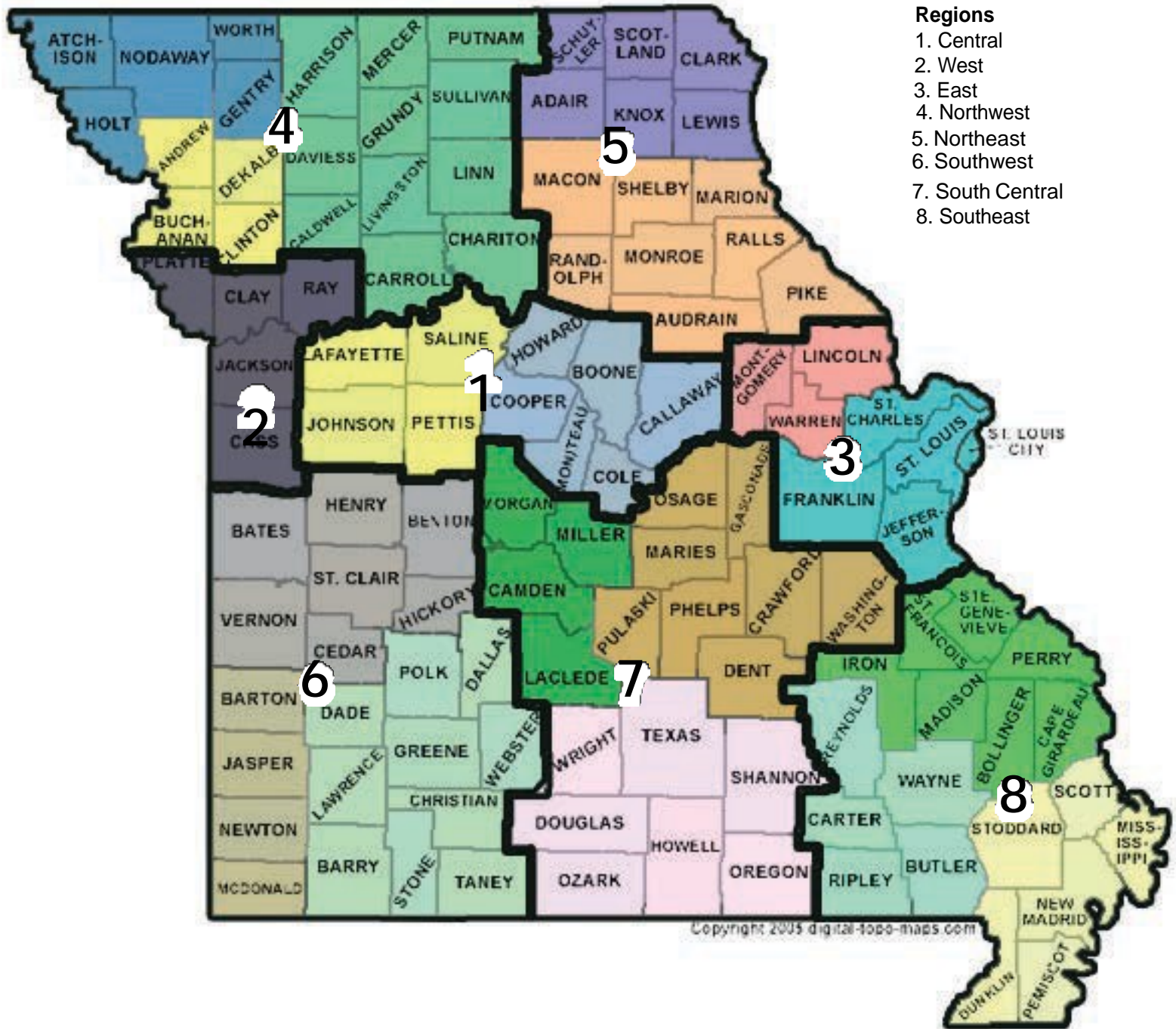
The scholarships are reserved for members attending their first ICMA conference. The scholarship program has also been developed to strengthen MCMA's strategic focus on stronger regional activities. One scholarship has been assigned to each of the eight MCMA regions (map enclosed to identify your region). The remaining six scholarships will be awarded at large.

The MCMA Scholarships will fund 100% of the annual conference registration fee. Travel, lodging and per diem are not part of the scholarship and will be the responsibility of the individual member.

Although only MCMA members are eligible for these scholarships, awardees **do not** need to be an ICMA member. Eligible staff can quickly and easily become MCMA members in order to apply for the scholarship. Application material is available on the website or by contacting any MCMA member. **Remember, dues have been waived for the first year of MCMA membership.**
